Meet Requirement Statement: This meet qualifies as one of two required long course meets to be eligible for New Jersey LC Zone Championship Team or for New Jersey National Championship Meet Reimbursement.

Facility: The pool is located in the Sonny Werblin Recreation Center on the Busch Campus at Rutgers University in Piscataway, New Jersey. The Center's main number is (732) 445-0460; *this number is for emergencies only*. All calls regarding this meet should be directed to either the Meet Director or if they regard entries, to the Entry Coordinator.

The pool is an Olympic-sized 50 meter 8-lane pool. The pool uses pedestal-style starting blocks, non-turbulent lane lines, and a Colorado Timing system.

There is an auxiliary pool for warm-up and warm-down, and seating for 1,000 spectators, including 400 chair-backed seats. The remaining seating is bleacher style.

Access to the pool deck will be via the staircase nearest the diving tower end of the pool. Stairs at the scoreboard end of the pool are for use only by officials, timers, and swimmers **exiting** the pool.

Meet Schedule: Due to Rutgers University security requirements, the doors open at 7:00 AM. No earlier.

Morning Session is for 10 and under, and 11 & 12 year old swimmers

7:10-7:35 10/U Warm-Up (last 10 minutes with sprint lanes)

7:35-8:05 11/12 Warm-Up (last 10 minutes with sprint lanes)

8:15 Events Begin

Afternoon Session is for 13-14 year old, and senior swimmers

1:00-1:25 13/14 Warm-Up (last 10 minutes with sprint lanes)

1:25-1:55 Senior Swimmers only (last 10 minutes with sprint lanes)

2:00 Events begin

Officials and Officiating: The 2001 USA Swimming Rulebook will govern the entire meet. The meet referee will be Mr. Sid Berkowitz. All inquiries regarding officials and officiating should be directed to Mr. Sid Berkowitz at (908) 756-2818.

Meet Eligibility: Age on June 2, 2001 will determine a swimmer's age for this meet. All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming for 2001. Entries for swimmers without valid 2001 USA Swimming registrations will not be entered in the meet. ***The enclosed New Jersey Swimming Meet Verification Form must be signed and included with all entries. Entries submitted without this form will not be processed.***

Meet Format:

- **General:** This is a timed finals meet. There are no relay events.
- **Heat Starting Information:** Swimmers will be required to remain in the water after completing their heat. Only after the next heat has been started will swimmers be permitted to exit the pool. All events will be started using the FINA start (whistle starting). Coaches are strongly encouraged to review this procedure with their swimmers prior to the meet.
- **Whistle Start / No-Recall Procedure:** All events will be started using the FINA start (whistle starting). As approved by New Jersey Swimming, this meet will use the "no-recall" procedure for false starts.
- **Possible Chase Format:** In order to accommodate as many swimmers as possible it may be necessary to run this meet in a chase format. This means that swimmers will be starting from both ends of the pool with the next heat starting while the previous heat is finishing.
- **Time Standards:** ***All qualifying times and entry times are in short course yards. This change is made to avoid the inevitable errors in converting times. The meet will though be swum as usual - long course.*** Time standards for this meet are attached. NJ Swimming Short Course Silver times are the minimum in each event. "NT" will not be accepted. Scarlet Aquatic Club reserves the right as host team to enter swimmers slower than the meet qualifying times.
- **Entries:** HyTek program entries on 3-1/2" diskette, labeled with the team name, (along with a hard copy) are required for teams with more than 25 entries, and strongly encouraged for all others (hard copy must be submitted on the enclosed Entry Form-please make copies as needed). ***Entries indicating a team affiliation, but not submitted as a team entry, will be held for entry until after all team entries have been entered. Entries held in this manner may not be entered in the meet if the meet exceeds time limitations before the entries are added.*** An Entry Summary with a signed waiver must accompany each entry, regardless whether entries are submitted on diskette or in writing. All diskettes will be returned with final results. Do not send entry cards with your entries. ***Entries must be submitted in SHORT COURSE YARD TIMES ONLY.***
- **Hy-Tek Meet Name:** SAC HEATMADNESS 2001
- **Club Participation:** Participating clubs are required to provide timers with watches, and as many certified officials as possible. Lane assignments for timers will be made after all entries are received. The assignments will be provided by phone, fax or mail, to the designated team contact representative (see Entry Summary attached) by May 30, 2001.

Check-In Procedures: All coaches are required to be in possession of and wear on deck, their USA Swimming coaches' credentials. Coaches are to check-in at the pool control room. Only current USA Swimming certified coaches will be permitted on deck, no exceptions. Check-in sheets will be distributed to coaches at the beginning of each session. Positive check-in will be required. Check-in deadlines will be announced over the public address system. Swimmers are to check-in with their coaches. Swimmers

not checked in by the deadline will be scratched from the session. **There will be a positive check-in for the 400 freestyle.** Check-in deadlines will be announced during the meet and will be posted at the control room.

Results: Results will be mailed or e-mailed to participating clubs. They will not be available at the end of the meet. Please indicate your preference for receiving results on your entry summary. If you elect to receive them by email, carefully print your email address. Results will be emailed within 24 hours of the end of the meet. Individual requests for results may be ordered at the admission window during the meet or by enclosing the \$10 fee with the entries. These results will be printed and mailed. Results will also be available at the Scarlet website at www.scarletaquatic.com/heatmadness.

Meet Scoring: This is a timed final meet. There are no relays and no scoring.

Awards: Medals will not be awarded. There will be novel recognition for every HEAT (commemorative / collectible Heat Madness 2001 pin) and EVENT winner. Heat winners will receive their pin at the conclusion of the heat. Event winners **MUST** pick up their awards during the meet. We will **NOT** mail or otherwise distribute any awards after the conclusion of the meet.

Meet Entry Limits: Entries will be accepted on a first come-first served basis. The meet director will notify the head coach by telephone if any entries, for any reason, are not accepted.

Individual Entry Limits: Swimmers may enter and compete in a maximum of three (3) events. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit the number of heats in the 400-meter freestyle, and reserves the right to consolidate the women and men's 400-meter freestyle for seeding purposes. Coaches will be notified in advance if the events close.

Meet Entry Deadline: All entries must be received by May 25, 2001, and priority will be given to NJ LSC teams in order of receipt, space permitting.

Express Mail is encouraged! If you send your entries via Express Mail, **please sign the release** so that the package will be delivered even if no one is there to sign for it.

Entry Limits: If any session of the meet is timed out to exceed timeline limitations, or if the number of swimmers for a session exceeds the facility limitations, the Meet Director reserves the right to refuse entries on a last-arrived basis even if the entries were received prior to the deadline.

Entry Fees: There is a non-refundable fee of \$3.00 per individual event. Fees must accompany entry packet. Fees for scratches are forfeited even if made prior to the date of the meet. Entries will not be considered received and accepted without full payment of fees. Please make checks payable to **SCARLET AQUATIC CLUB**.

Deck Entries: Deck entries will not be accepted.

Program and Admissions: Meet program is \$7 and admission is \$5 for the entire day.

Hospitality: A hospitality room will be maintained for coaches and officials. It is located behind the control room on the pool deck at the scoreboard end of the pool.

Food Service: Food and beverages will be available during the meet. The concession stand is located on the concourse level near the spectator entrance to the Recreation Center. A wide variety of food items

and hot and cold drinks will be available.

Swim Shop: The Metro Swim Shop will be located at the opposite end of the concourse from the spectator entrance and concession stand.

Weather Emergency: In case of extreme weather conditions, call the Scarlet Aquatic Club office at (732) 846-1423 for a recorded message.

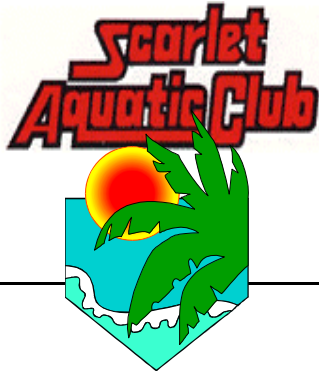

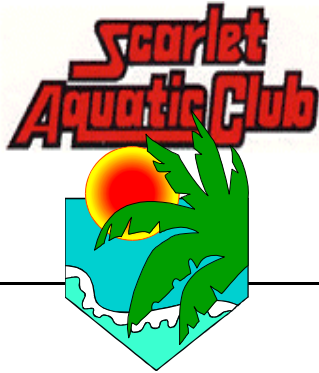

Directions to Sonny Werblin Recreation Center Rutgers University, Busch Campus, Piscataway, NJ

- **From the NJ Turnpike, North or South** - Take Exit 9-New Brunswick and pay toll. **Follow signs for Route 18 North-New Brunswick. Proceed along Route 18 North, crossing the Raritan River on the John Lynch Bridge, approximately 3.7 miles. Proceed through the light at the end of the bridge. ##Proceed along Metlars Lane approximately 2/10 of a mile and turn left onto Sutphen Road. Proceed another 3/10 of a mile turning right onto Frelinghuysen Road. The pool is several hundred yards ahead on your right.
- **From the Garden State Parkway Traveling South** - Follow Parkway South to Exit 129-New Jersey Turnpike. Travel south on the New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 9-New Brunswick. Follow directions from ** above.
- **From the Garden State Parkway Traveling North** - Follow Parkway North to Exit 105-Route 18. Take Route 18 North and follow directions from ** above.
- **From Route 287 Traveling North** - Take Route 287 North to Exit 9 (River Road, Bound Brook, Highland Park, 514 Spur). Follow River Road (514 Spur South) approximately 2 ¾ miles to Metlars Lane. Turn left onto Metlars Lane and follow directions from ## above.
- **From Route 287 Traveling South** - Take Route 287 South to Exit 9 (River Road, Bound Brook, Highland Park, 514 Spur) Follow River Road (514 Spur South) approximately 2 ¾ miles to Metlars Lane. Turn left onto Metlars Lane and follow directions from ## above.
- **From US Highway 1, North or South** - Take the exit for Route 18 North - New Brunswick and proceed from ** above.

Entrance to the pool is to the RIGHT of the parking lot. Due to Rutgers University security requirements, we are not permitted to open the doors prior to 7:00AM.

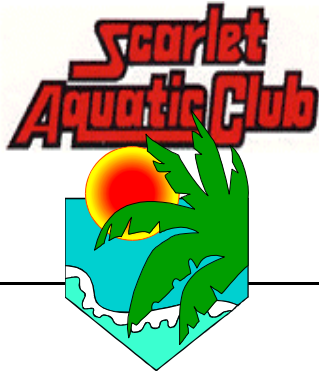

Article 302.4 of the United States Swimming Rules and regulations.

FALSE REGISTRATION: An LSC may impose a fine of up to **\$100 per event** against a member coach or a member club's representative signing a document which indicates a swimmer is registered with United States Swimming for a meet when that swimmer is not properly registered or eligible to compete for that club. This will be enforced by the LSC and the LSC will be entitled to the fines imposed.
